Academic Enrichment Courses:

Language Arts

Read and Write like a Trojan.

In conjunction with Language Arts Florida Standards (LAFS), students will receive hands-on instruction in a rigorous, yet engaging manner. Instructors will develop project-based and/or service learning experience. Instructors will incorporate, but are not limited to the following: creative writing, reading exercises, literature research, and informational text exploration. Analyzing, synthesizing, applying and inferring in connection with appropriate grade level topics will allow students to increase critical thinking skills all the while gaining knowledge

Mathematics

Count like a Trojan.

Utilizing the Mathematics Florida Standards (MAFS), instructors will facilitate student collaboration and interaction with relevant math manipulatives and other hands-on stimulants to reinforce standards and objectives taught during the regular school day. Instructors will develop systematic projects that connect with unit topics and program themes. Students will gain further insight on how math, and all of its components, connects with career choices and everyday living.

Referencing the Science Next Generation Sunshine State Standards (SNGSSS), instructors will expound on school day topics in a fun and engaging project-based manner.
