ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends approval of the recommendation and purchase order to award to Benson's Heating & Air Conditioning, Inc., the prequalified, responsible and responsive bidder meeting all requirements, and who submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$272,804.00.

ITEM SUMMARY: The Facilities and Construction Department issued an Invitation to Bid (ITB) 5689-2023 for Woodville PreK-8 School Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Replacement Project. Four (4) Contractors submitted bids in response to the above referenced Invitation to Bid. It is recommended that Bid 5690-2023 Woodville PreK-8 School Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Replacement Project be awarded to the prequalified, responsible and responsive bidder meeting all requirements, Benson's Heating & Air Conditioning, Inc who submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$272,804.00.

The recommended construction delivery method for this project is Bid. The scope of work is defined as Woodville PreK-8 School Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Replacement Project. District staffing is sufficient to provide the type of supervision needed on this project and has recent experience with similar projects. Costs will be monitored to ensure we stay within budget.

Benson's Heating & Air Conditioning, Inc. has earned an estimated amount of \$ 0.00 of projects over the past three (3) years.
