ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends approval of the recommendation to award to North Florida Asphalt, Inc., the prequalified, responsible and responsive bidder meeting all requirements, in the amount of \$86,487.00.

ITEM SUMMARY: The Facilities and Construction Department issued an Invitation to Bid (ITB) # 5517-2018 for Technology Parking Lot Milling and Resurfacing Project. Two (2) Contractors submitted bids in response to the above referenced Invitation to Bid. It is recommended that Bid # 5517-2018 Technology Parking Lot Milling and Resurfacing Project be awarded to the prequalified, responsible and responsive bidder meeting all requirements, North Florida Asphalt, Inc., in the based bid amount of \$86,487.00 plus a unit cost of \$75.00 per curb stop to replace curb stops that are broken or damaged while being removed with prior approval required by the Owner.

The recommended construction delivery method for this project is Bid. The scope of work is defined as milling and resurfacing only. District staffing is sufficient to provide the type of supervision needed on this project and has recent experience with roofing projects. Cost is always a priority consideration.

North Florida Asphalt, Inc.has earned an estimated amount of \$99,980.00 of projects over the past three (3) years.
