ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends Board action to approve negotiation with Shaffield Building Specialties the highest ranked firm for the Construction Manager at Risk Services for Woodville Elementary School, New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations & Site Improvements project, in accordance with F.S. Chapter 287.055, "Consultant's Competitive Negotiations Act." Should this negotiation fail with Shaffield Building Specialties, then request permission to negotiate with the next ranked firm. Once negotiations have been finalized, the contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

ITEM SUMMARY: The selection committee for the Construction Manager at Risk Services for convened on September 24, 2014 to interview construction management firms for Woodville Elementary School, New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations & Site Improvements project. Ten (10) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which four (4) were selected to interview. The committee ranked the firms as follows:

- 1. Shaffield Building Specialties
- 2. Albritton-Williams, Inc.
- 3. Sperry & Associates, Inc.
- 4. LLT Building Corporation

The scope of work is: New Construction; Add Dining area, Kitchen & serving area, Kitchen chair storage, 1 multi-purpose room (dining), Multi-purpose room chair storage, Stage, Stage storage, (Stage) 1 Male Dressing area and 1 Female Dressing area, Booth/projection room, 1 Male Student Restroom, 1 Female Student Restroom, 1 Male Staff Restroom, and 1 Female Staff Restroom. **7,780 sq. ft. \$1,392,620.00**

Remodeling Building 4: Convert rooms 401, 402, 402A, 404, 406, 407, 408, 409, & 411 to 3 Primary Classrooms,1 Resource Room, 1 storage, 2 Teacher Planning office, 3 material storage, 3 Outside Storage, 3 Student Storage, 3 Student Restroom (Both Sexes), 1 Male Staff Restroom, 1 Female Staff Restroom and rooms. **4,525 sq. ft**. **\$407,250.00**
