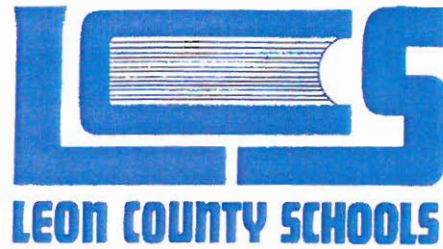

Part II - Scope of Services

The Leon County School Board is soliciting written Prequalification Applications and Statements of Qualifications from state certified general (CGC) and building (CBC) contractors who intend to submit bids and proposals for all facilities services and construction projects. This prequalification is applicable to bids, construction management, design-build, and any other construction services application. The Leon County School Board intends to award a certificate to each entity deemed qualified and responsive to this request. As a part of the process, LCSB will review and qualify applications for prequalification based on the uniform and consistent qualifications pursuant to Chapter 1013.46 Florida Statute, Chapter 4.1 SREF, and School Board Policy.

The request for bids and proposals on facilities services and construction services shall include, but are not limited to the following: Pre-construction services (value engineering, cost analysis, and scheduling evaluations), bidding and contracting with all subcontractors, coordinating scheduling of the work, supervision of the work and working with the LCSB Architect of Record on the project. LCSB will issue building permits, certificate of occupancy, and provide building code inspection.

Completion and submission of this application is required in order for your company to prequalify and therefore become eligible to submit bids and/or proposals for future facility services and construction projects for Leon County Schools.

Completing this application does not guarantee your company will receive an invitation to bid or any type of solicitation or a contract from Leon County Schools, nor does it imply that your company has any type of procurement and/or contractual relationship with Leon County Schools now or in the future. Information provided by submitting firms will be subject to disclosures pursuant to the Laws of the State of Florida.

All applicants determined to be qualified will be issued a certificate valid for one year as described in Part III of the instructions.
