**ACTION REQUESTED:** The Superintendent recommends Board approval for the negotiation with the architectural firm of Hoy+Stark Architects the highest ranked firm for Springwood Elementary School New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations & Site Improvements Project, in accordance with F.S. Chapter 287.055, "Consultant's Competitive Negotiations Act." Should this negotiation fail with Hoy+Stark Architects, then request permission to negotiate with the next ranked firm. Once negotiations have been finalized, the contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

**ITEM SUMMARY:** The committee for the appointment of architects convened on August 30, 2017 to interview architectural firms for Springwood Elementary School New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations & Site Improvements Project. Eight (8) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which five (5) were selected to interview. The committee ranked the firms as follows:

- 1. Hoy+Stark Architects
- 2. MLD Architects, LLC
- 3. Gilchrist Ross Crowe, P.A.
- 4. Barnett Fronczak Barlowe Architects
- 5. EMO Architects, Inc.

The total estimated construction budget Springwood Elementary School New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations & Site Improvements Project is \$2,800,000.00.

Hoy+Stark Architects has earned \$521,496.70 of Leon County School Board projects over the last 3 years.
