ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends Board approval to approve negotiation with the engineering firm of McGinnis & Fleming Engineering, Inc. the highest ranked firm for Cobb Middle School Underground Waterline Replacement Project, in accordance with F.S. Chapter 287.055, "Consultant's Competitive Negotiations Act." Should this negotiation fail with McGinnis & Fleming Engineering, Inc., then request permission to negotiate with the next ranked firm. Once negotiations have been finalized, the contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

ITEM SUMMARY: The committee for the appointment of engineers convened on September 25, 2017 to interview engineering firms for Cobb Middle School Underground Waterline Replacement Project. Four (4) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which four (4) were selected to interview. The committee ranked the firms as follows:

- 1. McGinnis & Fleming Engineering, Inc.
- 2. H2 Engineering, Inc.
- 3. Pinnacle Engineering Group, P.A.
- 4. Dewberry Engineers, in. d/b/a Dewberry/Preble-Rish

The total estimated construction budget Cobb Middle School Underground Waterline Replacement Project is \$600,000.00.

The recommended construction delivery method for this project is Construction Management. Major tasks are defined but there is potential for unknown conditions and the need to work around the schools schedule. The type of work is not unique but coordination and timing of all the required trades is complicated. District staffing is not sufficient to provide the type of supervision needed on this project during the busy summer construction session.
