ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends approval of the Interview Committee's recommendation and authorizes to negotiation with Allstate Construction Inc. the highest ranked firm for the Construction Manager at Risk Services for Springwood Elementary School New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations & Site Improvements Project, in accordance with F.S. Chapter 287.055, "Consultant's Competitive Negotiations Act." Should this negotiation fail with Allstate Construction Inc. then request permission to negotiate with the next ranked firm. Once documents are complete and negotiations have been finalized, the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

ITEM SUMMARY: The interview committee for the Construction Manager at Risk Services convened on October 23, 2017, to interview construction management firms for Springwood Elementary School New Construction, Remodeling and Renovations & Site Improvements Project. Six (6) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which five (5) were selected to interview. The committee ranked the firms as follows:

1. Allstate Construction Inc.
2. RAM Construction & Development, LLC
3. Albritton-Williams, Inc.
4. Shaffield Building Specialties, Inc.
5. Culpepper Construction Company, Inc.

The total estimated construction budget for Springwood Elementary School is \$2,800,000.00.

The recommended construction delivery method for this project is Construction Management. Major tasks are defined but there is potential for unknown conditions and the need to work around the schools schedule. The type of work is not unique but coordination and timing of all the required trades is complicated. District staffing is not sufficient to provide the type of supervision needed on this project during the busy summer construction session.

Allstate Construction Inc. has earned an estimated amount of \$1,287,913.00 of projects over the past 3 years.
