ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends Board approval to approve negotiation with the engineering firm of Pinnacle Engineering Group, P.A. the highest ranked firm for Aquillina Howell Building Fire Alarm Replacement Project, in accordance with F.S. Chapter 287.055, "Consultant's Competitive Negotiations Act." Should this negotiation fail with Pinnacle Engineering Group, P.A., then request permission to negotiate with the next ranked firm. Once negotiations have been finalized, the contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

ITEM SUMMARY: The committee for the appointment of engineers convened on November 3, 2017 to interview engineering firms for Aquilina Howell Building Fire Alarm Replacement Project. Three (3) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which three (3) were selected to interview. The committee ranked the firms as follows:

- 1. Pinnacle Engineering Group, P.A.
- 2. McGinnis & Fleming Engineering, Inc.
- 3. TLC Engineering for Architecture, Inc.

The total estimated construction budget Aquilina Howell Building Fire Alarm Replacement Project is \$120,000.00.

The construction delivery method for this project is to be determined.

Pinnacle Engineering Group, P.A. has earned an estimated amount of \$9,100.00 of projects over the past 3 years.
