ACTION REQUESTED: The Superintendent recommends Board approval to approve negotiation with the engineering firm of Nobles Consulting Group, Inc. the highest ranked firm for RFQ 429-2018 Civil Engineer Consulting Services for Transportation Services Site Improvements Project, in accordance with F.S. Chapter 287.05 Nobles Consulting Group, Inc. then request permission to negotiate with the next ranked firm. Once negotiations have been finalized, the contract will be submitted to the Board for approval.

ITEM SUMMARY: The committee for the appointment of engineers convened on March 14, 2018 to interview engineering firms for RFQ 429-2018 Civil Engineer Consulting Services for Transportation Services Site Improvements Project. Five (5) firms submitted qualification statements for this project, of which five (5) were selected to interview. The committee ranked the firms as follows:

1. Nobles Consulting Group, Inc.
2. GGI, LLC dba Genesis
3. George & Associates, Consulting Engineering, Inc.
4. Dewberry Engineers, in. d/b/a Dewberry/Preble-Rish
5. Spectra Engineering & Research, Inc.

The total estimated construction budget for RFQ 429-2018 Civil Engineer Consulting Services for Transportation Services Site Improvements Project is \$2,500,000.00.

Nobles Consulting Group, Inc. has earned \$60,269.00 of Leon County School Board projects over the last 3 years.

The recommended construction delivery method for this project is Construction Management. Major tasks are defined but there is potential for unknown conditions and the need to work around the schools schedule. The type of work is not unique but coordination and timing of all the required trades is complicated. District staffing is not sufficient to provide the type of supervision needed on this project during the busy summer construction session.
