**Responses to Written Questions
RFP 492-2022
Data Cabling Equipment and Services (E-Rate)**

Question	Answer
1. Is there a preferred color for the Cat5e/6/6a cable drops?	Acceptable colors are blue, yellow, green, red, black, and grey.
2. Is there an idea of how much feet of cabling that will be needed per drop?	Each drop will require approximately 100 feet of cable, depending on the individual project scope.
3. How many cable drops will there be?	The number of drops will vary depending on the individual project scope.
4. Will the patch panels need to be punch down or feedthrough?	The patch panels must be punch down.
5. Is the 7' Floor Mounted Equipment Rack and 4 Post Floor Mounted Equipment Rack meant to be open framed?	The racks should be open and enclosed within a cabinet.
