#### **RCM Health Care Services**

- What agencies do you currently use for SLP services? The District uses Southeastern Therapy, Therapeutic Endeavors and CDB Consulting.
- 2. What rates do those agencies charge for SLP services? \$63 \$75/hour.
- 3. Will this be a single or multi-award? Multi vendor award.
- 4. How many hours were utilized in 2019? Approximately 7,500 hours in current FY.
- Will you allow teletherapy for the 2020-2021 school year? The District will consider teletherapy proposals.
- 6. How many hours of SLP services do you anticipate for the 2019-2020 year? Approximately 9,000.
- 7. How many SLP and SLP assistants do you anticipate needing for this contract? Needs will vary.
- 8. How much money in 2019 was spent on SLP services? Approximately \$566,000 in current FY
- 9. What is the annual spend that is projected for the contract? How will it be divided per year? Approximately \$600,000 per fiscal year.
