Duties

Meetings

Green Team will host pick up days on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday every week from 8:45 a.m. - 9:25 a.m. and will meet every first Friday of the month. The first meeting will be Wednesday, September 3rd, 2025. Students will work on a volunteer basis on pick up days.

Membership

Students in Grades 6-8 are eligible for applying for the Montford Green Team. Students must maintain good citizenship in all classes. As a member if you are not passing a class, your participation in pickup days will stop until the grade has improved. As a member of Green Team, if you receive a referral or have any twos in citizenship you may not participate for the remainder of the school year.

We will be collecting the recycling containers from each classroom and spending quite a bit of time outside improving our facilities so please dress appropriately for working on school grounds.
