- My 19th trip leading 8th graders to Washington, D.C. with Educational Tours (7 at Fairview Middle School and this will be our 11th trip at MMS)
- Contract with Annett Bus Lines and Educational Tours (Inverness, FI). One driver change on the way up and **two driver changes on the overnight trip back**. Educational Tours will provide licensed tour guides.
- Monday Ride Up, Tuesday Tour D.C., Wednesday Tour D.C., Thursday Tour Luray Caverns and Monticello, overnight return home, Friday – Arrive at MMS at 9:00 AM (excused from school, start spring break)
- Registration Deadline: Wednesday, December 1st. I have 3 buses reserved and I have to release unused buses on this day.
- The U.S. Capitol and The Bureau of Printing and Engraving are typically on our itinerary but are still closed. Currently there is a mask mandate in Washington, D.C. It is set to expire in January. We will be continuously monitoring the situation in Florida and Washington, D.C. and Montford Middle School/Leon County Schools reserves the right to cancel this trip at any time. If we cancel the trip, you will receive a full refund minus a \$10 credit card recovery fee.
- Health Cancellation by participant for a full refund until departure. Very important that we don't take any sick students/chaperones since social distancing will be difficult throughout the trip.
