Soccer tryouts are designed to evaluate players' individual skills, teamwork, and overall understanding of the game. Please note that tryouts are not run as a regular practice - they are structured to allow coaches to assess each player's abilities. Players will be evaluated based upon the skills they display when present at tryouts only. Players should come prepared to give their best effort.

Parents are not permitted on the field or in the gym at Montford during tryouts. Coaches will not speak with parents (outside of an injury or eligibility/clearance situation) during tryouts for any reason.

WEATHER

Please note that weather conditions may impact our scheduled soccer tryouts. In the event of certain conditions, tryout times or locations may need to be adjusted. We encourage players to regularly check our MMS Boys Soccer website for the most up-to-date announcements and any schedule changes.

ROSTER SIZE AND CUTS

Our soccer program is highly competitive and focused on developing skilled, disciplined players who contribute to the overall success of the team. To maintain that standard, we will keep only the number of players that best support the programs goals and team performance. Cuts will be made as needed, and an updated roster will be posted on the Montford Boys Soccer website following each day of tryouts.

TRYOUT INFORMATION

Requirements

Students are **INELIGIBLE** to tryout until **ALL** of the following requirements are met and on file in the Aktivate Portal System. Each form is posted on the Montford Athletics website.

- 1.e-signature approving the Leon County Schools Athletic Handbook.
- 2.completed HIPPA form
- 3.completed Activity Participation Form please check the box of all sports your child could possibly try out for. Failure to do so will require you to go back later and recomplete the form with additional sport approval.
- 4. Final signature for risk and information submitted.
- 5. a valid physical with doctor clearance check, doctor signature and date.
