



Noodletools and HF Research Directions







Step 5: Click "New project"




Call it "Scientist Report" or something to distinguish the project you are working on.


Step 6: Go to Projects tab at the top

Choose the correct project title.


Step 6- Click “New Source”

Choose the appropriate type of source that you are looking at. If unsure, just choose ‘website’ and ‘webpage’.




