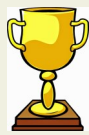

Welcome to Montford Middle School Athletics! Montford is a member of the Leon County Middle Schools Athletic Association. Our athletic teams compete against other middle schools in Leon County in sanctioned middle school sports. As Mustangs, we encourage our student athletes to tryout, practice, and compete with integrity, sportsmanship, and pride as representatives of themselves, their families, and our school.

Montford Middle School offers a variety of athletic options for our students, including: cross country, girls volleyball, football, boys soccer, girls basketball, girls soccer, boys basketball, track and field, softball, and cheerleading.
