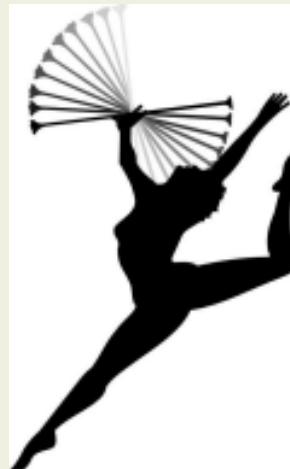


Athletic

Fellowship
