What are the benefits?

Students benefit from being involved in music in many ways! Academically

Students who actively participate in music education **show improved test scores in reading and math.** Music students are engaged daily in reading of notation and lyrics, and they use music vocabulary for interpreting the scores. These music-reading skills help develop and reinforce the text-reading skills of tracking, fluency, and vocabulary.

Students develop their understanding of symbol interpretation, fractions, and pattern recognition through reading and interpreting musical symbols. IN addition, music students <u>study</u> <u>historical periods</u> and world music for large groups and small ensembles. They explore the science of sound as well. **Music is academic!**

<u>Socially</u>

Students at the middle school level strongly desire to be a part of a group. In music classes, the students become a "family unit" through working together to create outstanding performances. Music classes teach mutual respect, constructive criticism, and the skill of PERFORMANCE. These skills carry over to other areas of a students life! Students will have increased confidence, self-assurance, and selfesteem in their interaction with other students and adults as a result of their participation in music. We see our students develop strong friendships and mutual respect through their involvement with music. Students learn to use their talents to the best of their ability, thus giving them confidence to try new things. *Music creates connections!*

<u>Physically</u>

Music students increase fine motor skills and dexterity in instrumental classes while using gross motor skills in choreography in vocal classes. Performing and moving in a nontraditional way gives students a chance to express themselves. Many students find their music class to be a physical "release" during the school day. The work music students do is handson and active. Students don't sit in desks and work with paper and pencil in music class; music students move, play, sing, dance, perform, and create in an energetic way.


Music is fun!
