CLASS EXPECTATIONS

* Access Full-time class

Our Access Classrooms use differentiated curriculum that is aligned to the state standards and targets functional academic skills and community experiences to enhance and promote learning and participation across all school and community settings.

ASD Full-time Class

Our ASD classroom is only available to incoming 6th grade Autistic students to help ease the transition to middle school. The students follow the same curriculum and pacing as the 6th-grade team, with the intentions of eventually integrating into the mainstream as soon as the student is able. Social skills and organizational/time management skills are also directly taught.



Supplies

Our supply needs are based on your child's individual schedule and the school's listserv and website posts the items needed by subject. If your child is in a CBI classroom, you will receive a specific list of items at the end of the second week of school after the individual assessments are completed and we have a better understanding of your child's supply needs. We do this in order to reduce the amount of purchases you have to make for your child.

Unique Skills

Students enrolled in the Unique Skills elective class are provided the opportunity to learn strategies and skills that will help them to be successful in their core academic classes.

Students will work on memory strategies, phonics/spelling/vocabulary, organization, self-advocacy, social skills, written language, note taking, comprehension and many other skills.

The class serves as a daily check-in for those students who need extra encouragement and reminders to see through the completion of their homework, projects, and studying for tests.
