#### **Academic Updates:**

The Leon County Schools Academic Services
Team has worked to provide a convenient
collection of learning packets categorized by
subject for Language Arts, Math, Science and
Social Studies. These resources review and
support key areas in academic content to
provide students with subject area enrichment
for what has already been covered this year
with students. The resources provide an
opportunity for students to continue working
while away from the traditional classroom

setting amid COVID-19. It is our hope that we will be reporting to school soon and the traditional classroom will once again be the primary way to teach and enrich our students, but until that directive it is important to provide some system of support for our Raa Rams and families.

We want to be respectful of what different families are dealing with at the moment, but also be able to provide some avenues for our scholars to be able to keep up with some of the grade appropriate academic skills during this time off.

Digital and paper copies of the Learning Packets will be available on March 30th and we will be sure to share the links and access for these once things are finalized. Our Front Office will also be open starting on March 30<sup>th</sup> from 8am – 12pm Monday- Friday for families to pick-up hard copies of the packets if you are not able to access them online.

Completed Learning Packets for Week 1 (March  $30^{th}$  – April  $3^{rd}$ ) and Week 2 (April  $6^{th}$  –  $10^{th}$ ) can be retuned the week of April  $13^{th}$  via hard copy to the front office or answers can be emailed directly to teachers via each students Classlink Portal.

At this time our campus hallways and classrooms are not open to the public and we will do our best to maintain respect for social distancing for those coming to pick-up paper copies of Learning Packets.

#### **Food and Support Items:**

We have been presented with an opportunity to host a **Drive Thru Farm Share Distribution Event** on our campus this **Wednesday, March 25**<sup>th</sup> **from 8am – 10am**. We will be giving out close to 15,000 pounds of food and this is open to the public. We will be stationed in the bus ramp and the entry point will be from 10<sup>th</sup>
Avenue. See attached flyer to spread the word.

The district has also set up 14 different school sites that will act as food distribution locations for **free breakfast and lunch** for students under the ages of 18 years old. Groceries will also be provided to each family unit. This will begin on **Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> around 10am**. See the flyer below for designated school locations.

We will work out a plan with the district on how best to process refunds and we are currently working with a few vendors regarding deposits. We will be in contact with families once we have more details on school operations.

For 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents that reserved their child's seat for the Washington, DC Trip with World Strides Travel Agency they are looking into allowing us to postpone the DC trip until late June in hopes that conditions and our situations improve.
