How do we spend our time?

- Reading, Writing, L.A.- (Wonders Curriculum)
 - New district mandate; Wonders curriculum supports 120 minutes of reading block
 - whole group, small group differentiated instruction
(Computer, Teacher, and Work Station)
 - various literatures to support weekly skill and strategy
 - Text- Evidenced Based Writing
 - Research and Inquiry:
 - encourages collaborative conversations; shared research and writing projects
- Math –(Go Math Curriculum)
 - whole group, enrichment or remediation, animated math models, and Work Stations
- Science/Social Studies/Handwriting
 - Science and Social Studies will be taught using an inquiry approach
 - Handwriting is taught Mon. Wed. and Fri.
- Special Areas
 - P.E., Music, Art
- 30 minute Computer Lab
 - I-Ready (Mon. and Wed. Reading; Tues. and Thur. Math; Fridays are I-Ready games if time is met)

What will my child learn this year?

- Review Phonics
- Blending sounds and fluency building
- Text-Evidence based Writing
- Higher order thinking skills in reading and math
- Number sense, data analysis, addition and subtraction strategies, counting money, geometric shapes, fractions, measurement of length, and telling time.
- The scientific method, living things, energy, water cycle, force and motion, and natural resources
- Civics and government, economics, geography, and human systems.
- Technology will be integrated through all subjects

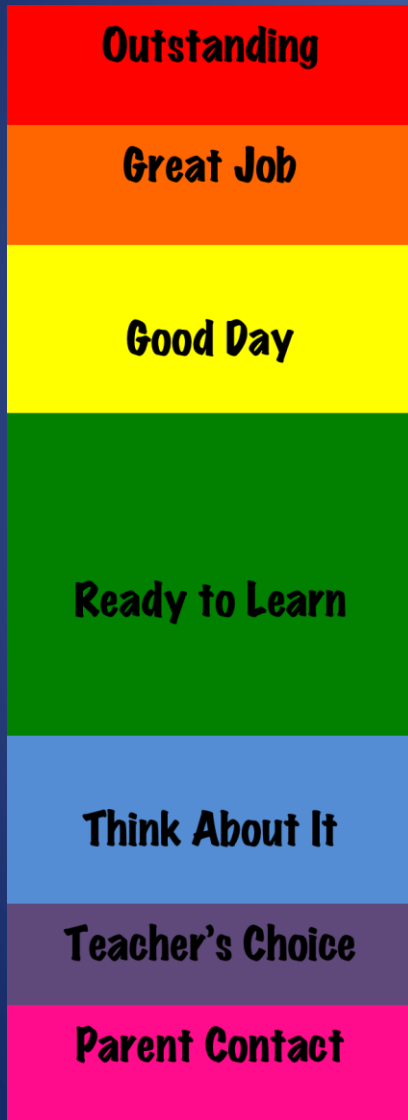

Rewards

1. Star- S.T.A.R students are given...

Consequences

- 1 **Warning** = Move Clip to "Think About It"
- 2 **Warnings** = Move Clip to "Teacher's Choice" and individualized behavior strategy is applied. No prize from Prize box and 10 minutes from Freeplay without other students.
- 3 **Warnings** = "Parent Contact" student will complete a thinking behavior sheet that will be placed in agenda book for parent to sign. 15 minutes from Freeplay without other students.

Homework

- Monday through Thursday
- Math homework is due back the next day
- 20 minutes of nightly reading
- Comprehension reading practice sheets are sent home Mondays and due back Fridays.
- completion grade not a percentage grade Note: Inconsistency impacts work study skills grade

Planners

- Brought home and to school every day
- Signed by parent/guardian every day
- Homework and behavior listed daily
