Description

The workshop will allow participants to become comfortable with foundational computer science concepts. Participants will explore the Florida's Standards for Computer Science and how to seamlessly integrate computer science skills within required math and science content. Participants will become familiar with using Scratch as a user-friendly block-coding platform and will be introduced to the CPALMS' collection for computer science resources. These resources include integrated math and science units for grades 4-8 that utilize Scratch for coding. Some of these lessons include the utilization of external scientific sensors and probe ware for collecting and utilizing live data as part of the coding. Sensors will be provided to interested participants at no cost to the participant or the district.

Key Goals

Those who attend will:

- Learn to integrate computer science skills within math and science content.
- 2. Connect Bluetooth scientific sensors to the Scratch coding platform and program the computer to collect data.
