Chapter 874 Criminal Gang Prevention Act: 874.03 Definitions Criminal gang means a formal or informal ongoing organization, association, or group that has as one of its primary activities the commission of criminal or delinquent acts and that consists of three or more persons who have a common name or common identifying signs, colors, or symbols, including but not limited to terrorist and hate groups. Criminal Gang Associate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admits to criminal gang association. • Meets any single defining criterion for criminal gang member. Criminal Gang Member: (meets two or more of the following) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admits to criminal gang membership. • Is identified as a criminal gang member by a parent or guardian. • Is identified as a criminal gang member by a reliable informant. • Adopts the style of dress of a criminal gang. • Adopts the use of a hand sign identified as used by a criminal gang • Has a tattoo identified as used by a criminal gang. • Associates with one or more known criminal gang members. • Is identified as a criminal gang member by an informant of previously untested reliability and such identification is corroborated by independent information. • Is identified as a criminal gang member by physical evidence • Has been observed in the company of one or more known criminal gang members four or more times.
