ALL medications, (prescription, over-the counter and selfadministered) must be submitted with the appropriate school health form(s). Please fill out the forms thoroughly. Parents/guardians must bring the medication and school health form(s) to the Chiles clinic. The medication will be counted, recorded and signed in on the medication log. Students are <u>not</u> allowed to drop off or pick up medication. School health forms must be updated yearly.

#### **Prescription Medication**

\*Daily medications that are taken during school hours and can't be altered.

- School health form on file and signed by healthcare provider.
- Prescription in original packaging.

Over-the-Counter Medication \* Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Benadryl

- School health form on file and signed by healthcare provider.
- The clinic will only hold a <u>5 DAY</u> supply, without the healthcare provider's signature.
- If your student will be in need of the medication longer than 5 days, the healthcare provider must approve and sign the school health form.
- Medication in original packaging.

#### Self-Administer/Carry

\*EpiPen , Inhaler

- School health form on file and signed by healthcare provider.
- Medication in original packaging.
