FSA Reading (April 5-6) Practice Test

This week students took a practice FSA Reading test. Students were given 80 minutes in “testing” mode similar to what they will experience on the actual day. I answered questions during the test to help students understand directions, style of test, etc. They were also given time later in the day to complete questions that they did not complete. I conferenced with each student to discuss ways to improve. For our first attempt, I told students that anything above 60% was a success. Please go over the test with your child and discuss the importance of focus, pacing themselves, and using the reading strategies that we have used throughout the year. We will have another practice test next week that is the official FSA Practice Assessment.

I have also included a FSA ELA Study Guide (3rd-5th) that you may go over with your child to discuss key concepts and terms.

Big Mix

Please continue to practice multiplication facts with your child nightly to develop multiplication fluency.
