

## **Parent Information**

- Students were introduced to the **Learn At Home- Teams** tab that is located on their **ClassLink** in our Zoom meeting last Thursday. I am posting all assignments that are listed below so that they can work independently. I have tried to think of questions or problems that will come up, but I am sure that there will be more. 😊 Students will be starting slowly with programs that they are already familiar with and I will add other things that I think will enhance learning as students are more comfortable with their schedule and working with technology. I would appreciate any feedback that you have. I want students to be engaged in learning and looking forward to their daily schedule.
- I have tried to provide a variety of online, paper/pencil, and creative activities for students. In the bag that was picked up Saturday, I included everything that was in their desks so that they have supplies along with any personal items from the classroom. The plastic bag has all of the packets/ books that they will need for assignments for the next 2 weeks.
- **An assignment list will be sent to families on Sunday night for each week.** The assignments will be due the following Monday to give students and families some flexibility. It will also be posted to my webpage on the Roberts site. Feel free to stick to the daily schedule or vary it as needed for your family.
- Set office hours are listed below so that students can get immediate answers to questions they may have. You can e-mail me or students will be able to go directly to their Teams tab and ask me questions in the chat room available. I can also call individual students and have a face to face chat via Teams if the student needs something more visual.
- The office hours mean I will be sitting by my computer at that time for immediate availability. They are welcome to post questions or you can send an e-mail at other times and I will get back to them or you quickly.
- I am not collecting all assignments from students. I have specific things that I will instruct the student to have their parents send me a picture/ scan to earn a grade. Many of the things that I am assigning have online quizzes or assignments that let me see the student's work.
- **Students should complete assignments on the daily schedule and the Weekly To Do list.** I have also provided some optional activities for them that I may add to as we go along. Students have a spiral notebook in their packets so that they can do the Journal activity.
