

- 1.R = Religion, Assembly, Speech, Press, Petition
- 2.A = Arms (bear arms)
- 3.S = Soldier Quartering
- 4.S = Search & Seizure (privacy amendment)
- 5.D = Due process, Double Jeopardy, eminent Domain

Don't have to testify against yourself (rights of the accused)

- 6.A = Attorney & fair and speedy jury trial (criminal)
- 7.T = Trial by Jury in Civil Suits over \$20
- 8.E = Excessive Bail or Cruel and Unusual Punishment
- 9.P = People's Rights ("unenumerated" rights: we have more than are listed in the Constitution)
- 10.S = States' Rights (If a power isn't listed, the Feds won't get it!)

Other Amendments

13 CW: Ended Slavery
14 CW: "Citizenship" definition extended to all born or

naturalized citizens. This included most freedmen.

: Equal protection under the law (Due Process) given to

all freedmen.

15 CW: Right to vote (suffrage) granted to African American adult males.

19: UNIVERSAL suffrage: all women allowed to vote by 1920 (!)

24: Poll Taxes (a type of "Jim Crow" law) now illegal

26: Voting age lowered to 18 in the wake of the Vietnam War

Amending the Constitution: Deliberately Difficult

Proposal:

Federal Level

- *2/3 of Congress must ratify the proposal
- * States can call for a convention if they want an amendment proposed... 2/3 vote

Approval:

State Level

- *3/4 of States' Congress must ratify
- *3/4 of Ratifying Convention
