

Music Theater Assignments for the two weeks of April 13-17, First due on 4/20 and April 20-24 and second due 4/27.

Directions: For the first two weeks, each week’s assignment is worth a total of 100 points in the grade book. Each week it will be evaluated on if all parts of the assignment completed and are well done. To earn your 100 points each week, you must complete assignments in the grid that add up to 3 points. So you could do one tier 3 assignment, or one tier 2 and one tier 1 or three Tier 1. The second week you will have the same options as the previous week (Same Grid), but you must complete different assignments to total 6. If you want to just do 6 points total, that works too, but the grade will be split into two 100 point grades. Make sure when you turn in your assignments, please make sure you include your name, the class period you are in, and the title of the assignment (the bold in each box). If you do the bonus for 9 points, you have extra points waiting for the next assignments.

<p>Patterns are Meant to be Broken Break a pattern and do something to day that you haven’t done in a while. Something unexpected. Send me a pic or video of you doing it with a written explanation of what you did and how it made you see things differently to break a pattern.</p>	<p>Who Are You? Who are you during this quarantine? Who have you become? Write a monologue about how you are feeling and what your thoughts are about this whole thing. It needs to be 30 sec to 1 min long. Submit it via Word through email or focus and get a bonus 2-points on the assignment if you video tape/ perform it. Submit it to me via email or we can do in TEAMS.</p>	<p>Show Stopper Write a show stopping number from Corona the Musical. Sing it for me. You can rewrite the lyrics to another song, or write the music yourself too. Include in writing, the title and lyrics. Then record either a video or audio of you singing the song. Submit the video via email.</p>
<p>New Tricks Learn how to do something new, something you’ve never done before, but always wanted to do. Bonus if it’s something theatrical. Send me a pic or video and an explanation of what you learned, how it worked out, and why you wanted to learn it.</p>	<p>Puppet Masters Make puppets out of anything you want around your house (dolls, sock puppets, action figures) and perform a scene from a play, musical, or movie. Submit the video to me via email.</p>	<p>Monologue Performance Choose any monologue and learn it and perform it. Use proper facial expressions, tone of voice, and body movements to truly get into the character of your monologue. This assignment can be repeated twice.</p>
<p>Movie Time Watch any movie musical you’ve never seen before. Give a brief synopsis of the story, and your impressions of it, what you liked and didn’t like about it (be specific). This assignment can be repeated three times. Send through email or focus.</p>	<p>Show in Minutes Do a video to reduce any play, musical, or movie into a 2-3 min video summary. Acting each character, yourself. https://www.instagram.com/tv</p>	<p>Ted Talks Watch one of the Ted Talks on this site: performerstuff.com and create a powerpoint detailing the important information you learned about acting from this Ted Talk. This assignment can be repeated three times.</p>
<p>Tony Tales Watch some Tony Performances and choose your favorite performance. Explore the show this performance came from. Listen to more of it, watch videos from it, and tell me all about it. What your liked most about it, and why. This assignment can be repeated three times. Learn how it came about, how long it took to do, credits, songs, ratings etc and share its accolades and accomplishments and whether it is touring, on Broadway, or retired. This should be 5 paragraphs well written in your own words.</p>	<p>BONUS – worth 9 points Connect with your classmates if able and perform what you worked on during the DC week for our pre-showcase planning. If you were on DC trip, connect with one or more classmate to rehearse this week and perform the next making 12 points. I will help you with connecting if you are interested.</p>
