- I. Welcome/Introductions:
 - a. All members were welcomed by the chairperson.

II. Celebrations:

a. Dr. Burch spoke about getting back to normal after our Covid year. Safety protocols with good staff Lincoln is currently extending the stage in the auditorium. In regards to sports we are looking forward to Senior night for volleyball team and the annual rivalry Lincoln/Leon football game is tonight.

III. Review of SIP

- a. Dr. Burch huge number of students working with learning loss from last year, more loss of credits than ever before which we are seeing state wide
- b. Needs Assessment
 - i. No ELA EOC in 2020, but small drops all around
 - ii. Bio stayed about the same
 - iii. US History stayed about the same
- c. Progress Monitoring (Governor's announcement that we will be moving towards no more EOCs, only progress monitoring)
 - i. We can use this data for this year, although somewhat incomplete
 - ii. No school grades from last year
- d. Data analysis
 - i. Biggest gain for lower level students: Mathematics (not separated by subject)
 - ii. Teachers can use this data for this year's instruction for identified groups
 - iii. Dr. Burch-Moving away from EOCs to PM is a great transition, allows teachers to focus on career/tech readiness and yearly progress. Teachers this year are working on subject area PD this year, with a focus on getting more teachers Reading Endorsed to fill in gaps due to learning loss.
 - 1. We currently have 3 sections of students in credit recovery compared to 1 section in previous years. We want to be on top of this now, as opposed

to waiting later in the year. We would like to get that down to our 1 section by the end of the Fall semester

- e. Planning for Improvement
 - i. Reading classes due to lower English scores
 - 1. County push for Tier 2 & 3 interventions to help catch them up
 - 2. STAR assessments to monitor
 - 3. English Dept. PD with county presentations throughout the year
 - 4. Dr Burch meeting tomorrow with Solution Skills about free tutoring for our students, both in-person and virtual. Hope to start this for the 2nd Ouarter.
 - ii. Graduation Rates
 - 1. SAT/ACT school day administrations to help struggling students with credits
 - 2. Tutoring on campus through our Testing Coordinator
 - iii. Math lower scores last year
 - 1. Emphasis on Algebra I A&B students
 - 2. Math Dept PD focusing on progress monitoring
 - 3. Tues/Wed/Thurs after school tutoring
 - iv. Science lower Bio scores
 - 1. Science Dept PD focused on progress monitoring for bottom 25%
 - v. Social Studies US History EOC scores solid
 - 1. Social Studies PD focused on progress monitoring
