Dear Bobcat families,

As we move closer to Spring Break and warmer weather, I would like to ask for your assistance. During this time of year, we routinely have issues with our school dress code. Please help to ensure that your child's school clothes adhere to the follow:

- Students should not be wearing flip flops or slides.
- Clothing should fit properly. Clothing should not be too loose nor too tight.
- Undergarments should be covered at all times.
- Tank tops are allowed, but should be at least two inches wide.
