Dear Bobcat families.

I would like to ask for your help with our after- school dismissal. The most important thing we do every day is making sure that our students are safe as they arrive at school, stay safe while they're in class, and get home safely. Lately, we have been having some issues with our Gathering Place located at the front of the school. The Gathering Place is intended for families who live in adjacent neighborhoods who are walking home. It is not intended for parents to drive to the front of the school to bypass the car pick-up line.

We have had an increase in the number of students at the gathering place and an increase in the number of parents picking up by car at the front of the school. I have asked our Security Monitor and our Resource Officers to not permit parents to park in the front of the school to pick up students from the gathering place. If this impacts your family, please make other arrangements so we can keep all our students safe. Thank you for your help!
