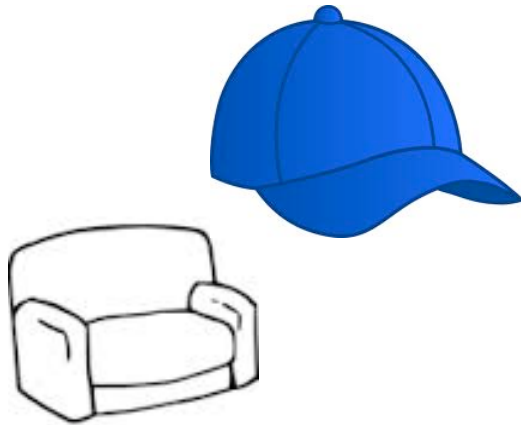


Language Tips

Definition:

Synonym - can be a noun, adjective, verb, or adverb and is a word that means the same or is similar in meaning to another word.

child/kid

couch/sofa

cap/hat

Adjectives

big/large

small/tiny

good/great

hungry/starving

bumpy/rough

Verbs

walk/hike

run/jog

like/enjoy

observe/watch

Adverbs

happily/cheerfully

quickly/swiftly

bravely/courageously
