Definition:

Adverb = a word that describes or clarifies the meaning of verbs, adjectives, or other adverbs. Adverbs answer the questions: how, when, where, how much, and how often.

Examples: Adverbs that answer: How - carefully, easily, loudly, quickly, quietly, slowly

When - later, soon, often, now, already, today

Where - here, there, upstairs, over there

How much - very, quite, too, completely, almost, entirely

How often - always, never, rarely, seldom, usually, sometimes
