Do some yard work.
Working in the yard is a great time to build skills and vocabulary.

Definition:

Regular Plural Noun = names two or more people, places, or things. **Regular plural nouns** are formed by adding either **-s** or, if the noun ends in a consonant plus **-y**, change the **-y** to **"i"** and add **-es**.

Examples:

Nouns ending with **-s** to form the plural

- Add **-s** to form the plural of most nouns

- cat/**cats**

- dog/**dogs**

- house/**houses**

- bike/**bikes**

- car/**cars**

- chair/**chairs**

For nouns ending with **-y** changed to **"i"** and add **-es** to form the plural

- city/**cities**

- party/**parties**

Words ending with **-sh**, **-ch**, **-x**, **-s**, or **-z** add **-es** to form the plural

-church/**churches**

- watch/**watches**
