Encourage your child to use accurate grammar and complete sentences throughout the day.



Do some yard work. Working in the yard is a great time to build skills and vocabulary.

Definition: Regular Plural Noun = names two or more people, places, or things. **Regular plural nouns** are formed by adding either **-s** or, if the noun ends in a consonant plus -y, change the -y to "i" and add **-es**.

Examples: Nouns ending with **-s** to form the plural - Add **-s** to form the plural of most nouns

- cat/**cats** - dog/**dogs** house/houses
bike/bikes

- car/**cars** - chair/**chairs**

For nouns ending with -y changed to "i" and add **-es** to form the plural - city/cities - party/parties

Words ending with -sh, -ch, -x, -s, or -z add **-es** to form the plural -church/**churches** - watch/**watches**
