Encourage your child to use accurate grammar and complete sentences throughout the day.



Building or participating in crafts is a great way to have a fun time while working on following directions.

Definition:

Irregular past tense verb = a word that describes an action that happened in the past.

These forms do not end in **-ed**. These verbs either keep the same spelling, change letters in the middle of the word, or change completely.

Examples:

Verbs that do not change form when referring to a past action.

- Today I **cut**. Yesterday I **cut**.
- Today the sun **set**. Yesterday the sun **set**.
- Today I **hit**. Yesterday I **hit**.

Verbs that change completely when referring to a past action.

- do/**did**
- hide/**hid**
- tell/**told**
- catch/**caught**

Verbs that change letters in the middle of the word when referring to a past action.

- come/**came**
- blow/**blew**
- draw/**drew**
- drink/**drank**
- drive/**drove**
- give/**gave**
