READ a BOOK	Talk about <u>GOLD</u> things around your home	Talk about all the words you can think of that start with the sound “d” as in “dog”	When folding laundry, talk about the items that are <u>MISSING</u> .	Clap, tap, or snap one time for every syllable in a word (i.e., clothes = 1; chocolate = 3)	When standing in line, talk about who is <u>FIRST</u> vs <u>LAST</u> in line.	READ a BOOK
READ a BOOK	Talk about items in your home that are <u>LIGHT</u> colors (i.e., gray, baby pink) vs <u>BRIGHT</u> colors (i.e., black, hot pink)	Talk about words that start with the sound “K” as in “kite” or “candy” and “L” as in “lollipop”	Whose shoes are the <u>SMALLEST</u> ?	Clap, tap, or snap one time for every syllable in a word (i.e., truck = 1; boxes = 2)	Find a book or plate at the <u>BOTTOM</u> of the pile	READ a BOOK
READ a BOOK	Talk about things around your home that are shaped like <u>RECTANGLES</u>	Talk about words that start with the sound “M” as in “monkey” and “N” as in “nut”	Talk about having a <u>BIT</u> or a <u>BUNCH</u> of something	Clap, tap, or snap one time for every sound in a word (i.e., truck = 4; hi = 2; box = 4)	Talk about <u>BETWEEN</u> when eating (the plate is between the fork and spoon), while sitting on the sofa (you are between your sister & me)	READ a BOOK
