READ a BOOK	Talk about <u>PINK</u> things around your home	Talk about all the words you can think of that start with the sound “d” as in “dog”	While blowing bubbles, see who can blow the <u>LARGEST</u> bubble.	Keep singing! You are sounding great :-)	When standing in line, talk about who is <u>LAST</u> in line.	READ a BOOK
READ a BOOK	Talk about <u>BLACK</u> things around your home	Talk about all the words you can think of that start with the sound “e” as in “elephant”	While taking out the trash, talk about which bag is the <u>LARGEST</u>	Sing the nursery rhymes some more but this time change some words and make up your own songs	Who was the <u>LAST</u> one to get up from the dinner table?	READ a BOOK
