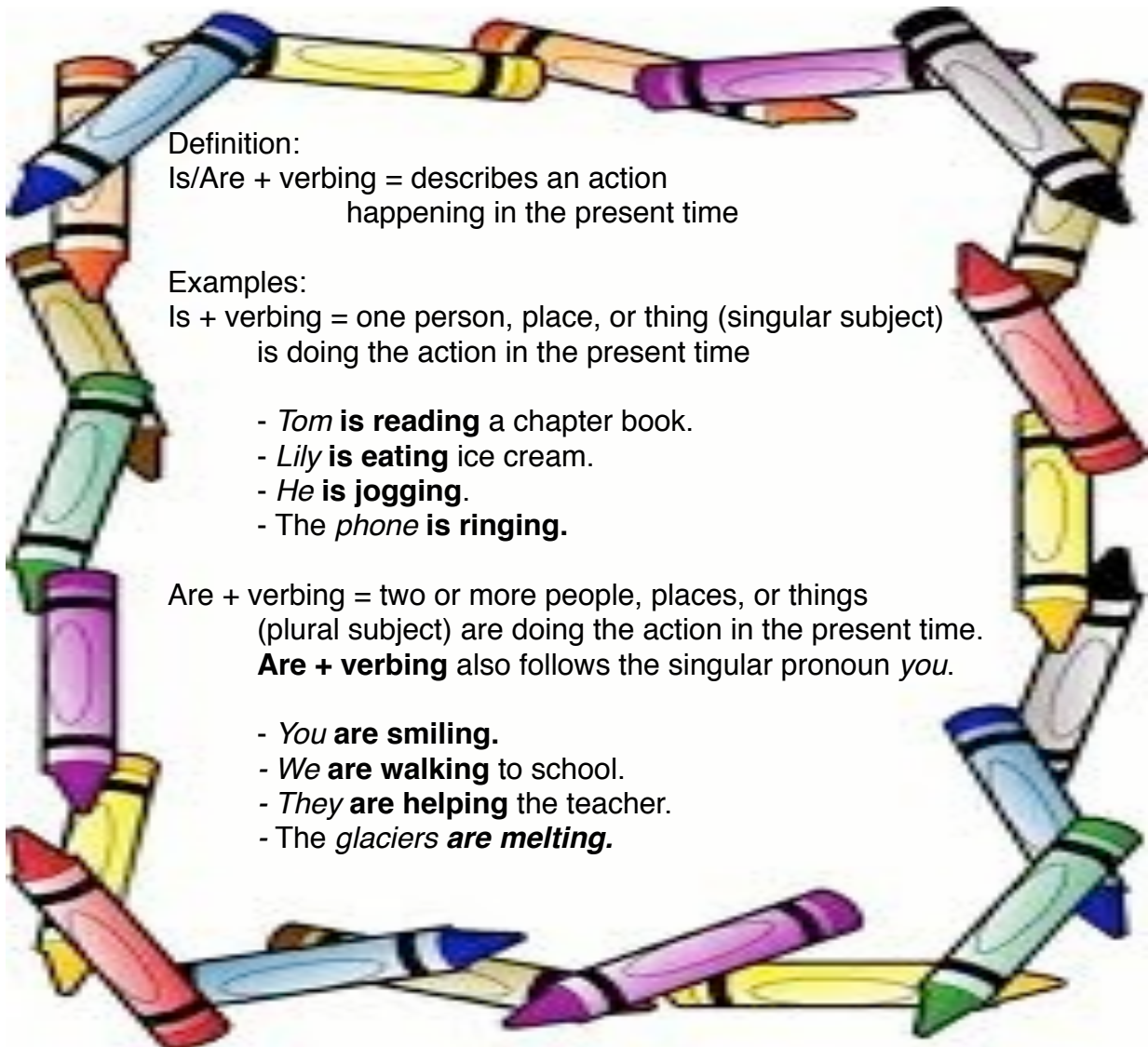


Language Tips

Is/Are + Verbing Homework



Definition:

Is/Are + verbing = describes an action happening in the present time

Examples:

Is + verbing = one person, place, or thing (singular subject) is doing the action in the present time

- *Tom is reading* a chapter book.
- *Lily is eating* ice cream.
- *He is jogging*.
- The *phone is ringing*.

Are + verbing = two or more people, places, or things (plural subject) are doing the action in the present time.

Are + verbing also follows the singular pronoun *you*.

- *You are smiling*.
- *We are walking* to school.
- *They are helping* the teacher.
- The *glaciers are melting*.
