#### Leon Writes Basic Technology Guidance

#### **General Information:**

The Leon Writes items listed in the chart below will only be available for student use during the administration window of **October 20 – November 7**.

Navigating in Unify is easiest when using the Test ID #s.

Teachers can utilize the SAMPLE Leon Writes to practice assigning, unassigning, and resuming student tests if needed.

The SAMPLE Leon Writes can also be assigned to students and used in a mini-practice session before the actual testing date in order to make sure all students can access Unify with their Chromebooks and can become familiar with the platform tools. The tools work differently on the left side of the panel (Sources) because these are in a pdf format.

This SAMPLE is NOT designed to be a test or used for scoring, only as practice with the platform.

The SAMPLE should be <u>unassigned</u> to students BEFORE the actual day of the assessment, and the appropriate grade level Leon Writes must be assigned.


From the menu on the left side, click Tests, then Assessment Manager:



Find the test you want to administer; click the 3 dots on the right side under Actions, then "assign online/paper based":




This Action will open a pop-up window listing your students. Click the students that you want to assign the assessment to (or the option at the top to select all) and then click the Assign button at the bottom:

Click the Unify tile in your Classlink dashboard:




Utilize the menu on the left side. Click Tests, then Assessment Manager:

Find the test you want; click the 3 dots on the right side under Actions, then "OLA Student Status":



Make sure you have clicked Live Updates, and Apply Filters.



Utilize the dashboard to track student progress. Students who have clicked Pause will show 'In Progress' until their test is submitted. (The Lock function is not set for Leon Writes.)

We do not have a secure browser so it is important for Test Administrators to closely monitor the session (e.g., circulating, GoGuardian).

Students who select "Pause" should be able to resume their test when they log into the assessment at a later time. Their work is automatically saved.


