General Grading Policy

- Assessments will have a numerical and letter grade on the paper. An explanation of the grading scale is on the back of this sheet.
- Classwork will have the following codes: +, $\sqrt{+}$, $\sqrt{\cdot}$, $\sqrt{-}$, -. These codes are also explained on the back of this sheet.
- Not all papers that are graded will be recorded on Focus (the online gradebook). For example, some are considered practice if the concept has recently been introduced.

Grading Policy (continued)

1. Daily work will be monitored through completion of daily assignments, teacher observation and conferencing with student.
2. A variety of assessments will be given periodically in all subject areas. Grades will be given in accordance with Leon County Pupil Progress guidelines.

A	Student has learned and can use at least 90% of the skills/concepts/processes outlined by the Grade Level Benchmarks taught during the nine weeks <i>and</i> daily work consistently meets high quality standards.
B	Student has learned and can use at least 80% of the skills/concepts/processes outlined by the Grade Level Benchmarks taught during the nine weeks <i>and</i> daily work consistently meets acceptable standards.
C	Student has learned and can use at least 70% of the skills/concepts/processes outlined by the Grade Level Benchmarks taught during the nine weeks <i>and</i> daily work consistently meets acceptable standards.
D	Student has learned and can use at least 60% of the skills/concepts/processes outlined by the Grade Level Benchmarks taught during the nine weeks <i>and</i> daily work is inconsistent in meeting acceptable standards.
F	Student has learned and can use at least 60% of the skills/concepts/processes outlined by the Grade Level Benchmarks taught during the nine weeks <i>and</i> daily work is not acceptable most of the time.

3. Homework will be assigned and reflected in the work and study skills grade.
4. Classroom behavior and work/study habits will be monitored through teacher observation and anecdotal records. Performance codes of E, S, and N will be given in these areas.

FINAL GRADES - Final grades will be based on daily work, projects, performance assessments and written tests.
