\*Since this performance is in Tallahassee, transportation will be your responsibility. Carpooling would be wise.

\*After you have checked the schedule for your performance time(s), plan accordingly. Read: **ARRIVE EARLY**. Plan to be on site at least ***an hour*** before your scheduled event. This will give you plenty of time to check in, find your performance room, the warm up area, and allow you time to warm up. *Then, plan to be outside your performance room 10 minutes before your performance time.*

### Equipment Checklist

Uniform:

- Dress clothes: “Sunday best”
- If you are playing with an ensemble (duet, quartet, etc.) you can color coordinate if you so choose. Optional.
- Percussion Ensemble – “Concert Black” (Dress shirt, Dress pants, black shoes/belt.) Optional dark green accents.
- No jeans, no sneakers.

Equipment:

- Instrument
- Mouthpiece
- Reeds, valve oil, drum sticks, mallets
- Percussionists playing a snare solo will need to bring their own snare drum.
- Music: IMPORTANT! You need music for yourself, then be sure your accompanist has their music, **and an original for the adjudicator!** (*Measures numbered!*)
