7th Grade Immunization Reminder

All students entering seventh grade are required to receive a specific form of the "Tetanus" vaccine. This vaccine is referred to as the Tdap (Combined Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis Vaccines). Documentation from the student's health care provider should specify that the student has receive the Tdap vaccine on the Florida Certificate of Immunization (680 form). Students who cannot receive the vaccination due to medical or religious contradictions, must present a permanent medical or religious exemption on the Florida Certificate of Immunization (680 form) from their medical provider.

7th Grade students will not be allowed to pick-up a schedule or attend classes until Immunization Records have been updated.

2019 - 2020 Supply List

The following list is a generic supply list.

Specific course items will be provided during the first week of classes.

- ✓ 1 three ring binder (1" or larger), with pockets, clear plastic cover sleeve and additional pocket folders to add inside
- ✓ 1 set of dividers
- ✓ 1 pack of highlighters
- ✓ 1 small (hand held) pencil sharpener with compartment for pencil shavings for desk use
- 2 bound composition books
- ✓ Additional binders/folders may be required depending on the student's schedule
- <u>Generous supply</u> of notebook paper, pencils, and pens (blue/black ink recommended)
- ✓ 4 function calculator with square root, percent and integer buttons (integer buttons may resemble +/-)

Suggested Home Materials: paper, metric ruler, pencils, pens, glue, scissors, colored pencils and markers.

Backpacks: Backpacks are not allowed to be taken into the classrooms. For the schools' purpose, a backpack is defined as any bag containing two straps designed to be carried over one or both shoulders. All backpacks must fit in the lockers. The dimensions of lockers are 36hx12wx12d or 24hx12wx12d. Agenda Books: All students are required to have an Agenda Book. The first agenda book will be provided to students free of cost. Any additional agenda book will be available for a cost of \$5.00.

* Please Note *

All school locks are provided for each child to rent at a cost of \$2.00. Replacement locks may be provided at a cost of \$5.00

Students should not bring all their supplies on the first day of school. Back packs will not be permitted during the 1st week of school. Lockers are not issued until Friday of the first week. During the first week of classes have your child bring <u>only</u> the basics (i.e. what he/she will not mind carrying around with them all day) until instructed otherwise by specific teachers.
