8th Grade Address Verification Required

According to Leon County School Board Policy 5112, the residential address of students who are promoted from middle to high school must be verified.

Verification required includes two (2) of the following items:

- Current lease, mortgage or rental agreement, must include the contact information of the property owner or rental company;
- Current Homestead Exemption card or home owner's insurance proof;
- Current electric deposit payment receipt or electric bill, bottom portion showing name and service address and/or driver's license with correct address.

The required proofs of residence must be provided to the attention of our registrar, Ms. Leneatris Thomas and can be emailed to Thomasl4@leonschools.net

If the required documents are not received, 8th grade students **may not** participate in any of the End Of The Year Activities, the 8th Grade Promotion Ceremony, **will not** receive their End-Of-Year reports cards, **nor** will they receive their High School schedules in the fall.
