ROUND UP FOLDERS

• A Round Up Folder will go home every Friday. In the folder you will find your child's work from the week plus important school information. Please take EVERYTHING in the folder out and KEEP at home. Discuss with your child the papers they have completed and make sure to give them praise for their hard work! We encourage students to complete any unfinished work at home. Send the empty folder back with your child <u>every Monday</u> morning.



- Inside the folder you will find teacher information and our class schedule. Please leave this inside so that you may refer to it throughout the year.
- A behavior sheet will be found in the very back pocket of the folder. This will let you know your child's behavior for the week.
 Please discuss your child's behavior with them!





Remind is a text reminder application that allows the teachers to send out classroom and school reminders via text message. We can send out reminders to all of our parents at once or individual texts. This also allows you to easily communicate back with us. We will do our best to respond during school hours, but you should usually get a response in 24 hours (if not a weekend). Top 5 nonacademic skills to work on at home, to help your child have a successful school year:

- 1. Be able to independently use the restroom and attend to their clothes. Examples: button their pants, pull up their pants, wipe themselves, change soiled clothes
- 2. Work on problem solving skills: let them struggle some to help build their growth mindset
- 3. Go to the playground as much as possible. Most problems happen on the playground with unstructured play. Let them navigate social situations on their own.
- 4. Open all of their food packed for lunch. A lot of times these items are really hard to open independently. Sometimes they are nervous to ask for help or it might take some time before an adult can help them and time will run out.
- Practice fine motor skills to help build strength in the muscles in their hands. We do a lot of cutting, gluing and writing in kindergarten. Examples: play with playdough, pick up tiny objects one by one, squeeze a ball.





We would like to offer a special drop off time for our new Kindergarten students for the first <u>three days</u> of school. This will allow the car pick up area to be clear of other traffic and less congested.

Your child's teacher will be out at car pick up at 8:50 to help with the transition into their new school. They will then be able to walk their students to the classroom.

You will not be allowed to walk your child into the classroom in the mornings.
