Project Care Information

Children who qualify for free or reduced lunch may receive a subsidy to the extent funds are available. Space is limited and scholarships are provided on a first come, first served basis.



- 1. Apply through *Nutrition and Food Services* (All students will still be receiving free lunch, however families will still need to financially qualify to receive Project Care)
- 2. Turn in Free/Reduced Meal acceptance letter to EDEP office
- 3. Turn in EDEP registration form(s) **and** Project Care application
- 4. Pay full-priced EDEP fees via check, money order, or credit/debit card through FOCUS portal
- 5. Wait to receive Project Care acceptance letter during the first two weeks of school

Please be advised that Project Care spaces are limited and usually fill up during registration day. We strongly recommend arriving early. While we do have a wait list, once the allotted spaces have been filled, new spaces do not typically open unless a current Project Care student leaves the program.



Families must reapply each year. Receiving Project Care during the 2020-2021 school year does not guarantee a space for the current year.
