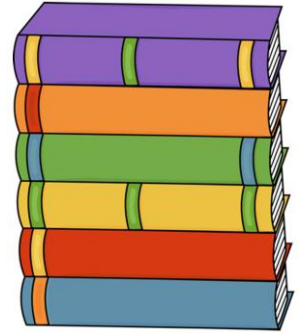

- 10% Weekly Classwork

# LANGUAGE ARTS HW



- AR Reading 20-30 mins. daily
- Study Spelling Words- Test every Thursday
- Vocab. Packet (Goes home Friday and due the following Friday)

# ACCELERATED READER

- AR book comes home daily and should be read 20 minutes and returned to school the next day
- AR tests CAN be taken at home.
- Parents receive weekly updates in planner- please initial the label each week
- Parents can sign up for HomeConnect for automatic updates
- Students are expected to reach AR Goals:  
88% comprehension & 100% of point goal



# HOW CAN I AS A PARENT HELP WITH AR?

- Read to and with your child... they aren't too old for this!
- Ask your child what they are reading.
- Set page goals for accountability.
- Set aside 20 minutes for AR daily. Set a timer if needed
- If your child has trouble staying focused, purchase a whisper phone to use.
- Sign up for a public library card and use the library card number to explore free eBooks and audiobooks on the Axis360 and/or Libby app.



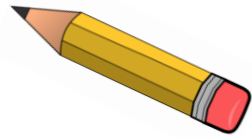

- 10% Classwork

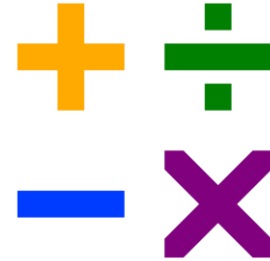

Daily math homework is given (only every other problem is required, but your child can do more if they wish)

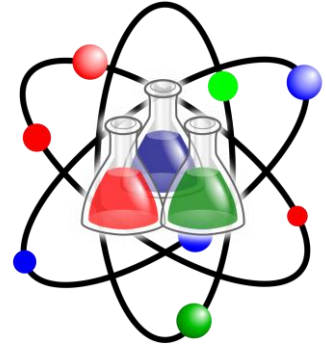


If your child struggles with math homework or wants to review for a quiz/test:
