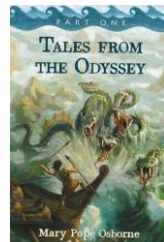
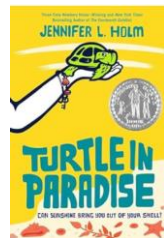
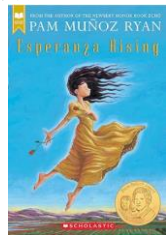
- 50% Assessments

LANGUAGE ARTS HOMEWORK

- AR Reading 20 mins. daily
- Study Spelling Words- Test every other Thursday
- *SpellingCity has our words uploaded for digital practice.
Access on ClassLink
- Vocab. Packet (Goes home Friday and due the following Friday) *Students are encouraged to work together on this at the end of each day*



ACCELERATED READER

- AR book comes home daily and should be read 20 minutes and returned to school the next day
- AR tests CAN be taken at home.
- Parents receive weekly AR updates on Fridays in the binder
please initial the paper each week
- Parents can sign up for HomeConnect for automatic updates
- Students are expected to reach AR Goals:
88% comprehension & 100% of point goal

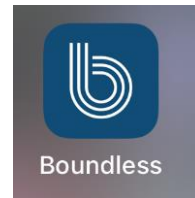
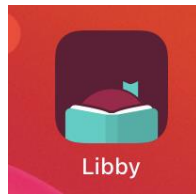
HOW CAN I AS A PARENT HELP WITH AR?

- Read to and with your child... they aren't too old for this!
- Ask your child what they are reading.
- Set page goals for accountability
- Set aside 20 minutes for AR daily. Set a timer if needed
- If your child has trouble staying focused, purchase a whisper phone to use or let them record themselves reading.



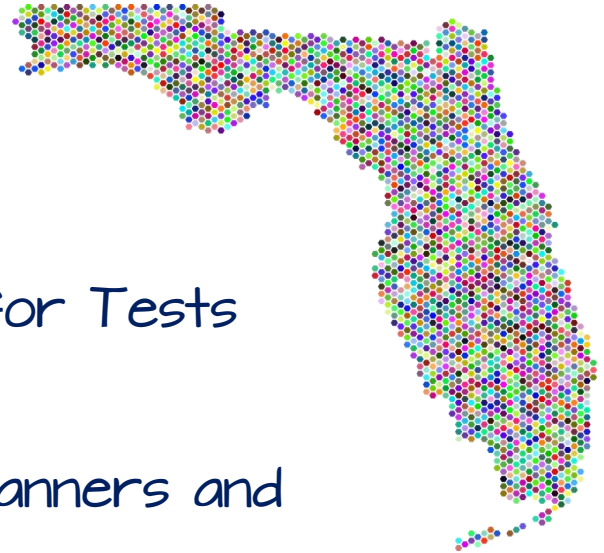
My child doesn't like reading and AR is a struggle... help!

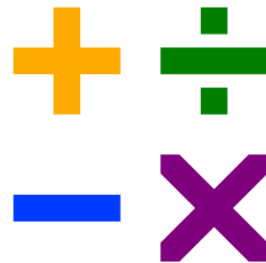

MATH HOMEWORK

Daily math homework is given (only EVEN numbers are required, but your child can do more if they wish)

If your child struggles with math homework or wants to review for a quiz/test:

- In ClassLink your child has access to Ed which has interactive lessons for class pages and HW, reteach pages, and the exact textbook pages we worked on in class
- My website has videos teaching the skill for most math lessons
- Students can review the completed math textbook packet (it's colorful) when it comes home at the end of the chapter





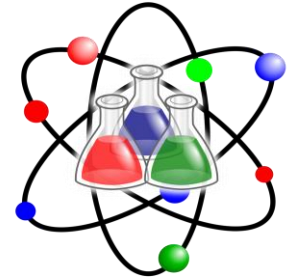
MATH HOMEWORK

*I use the homework to pull math small groups for extra help. If your child isn't bringing their finished homework to school, they are missing out on this!


