It's been a very exciting week with the Boosterthon Fun Run and Valentine's Day! We have all had so much fun! We have also been enjoying our new unit, Animal Fun. This week, we "turned over" two new letters, Oo and Rr. We read the pre-decodable book, **I Can See**, copies are in folders today. We also read the book, If You Take a Mouse to School and the folktale, James and the Dancing Sheep. During our story time, we worked on character identification, setting, vocabulary and making predictions. In Sounds and Letters, we worked on beginning and ending sounds, blending word parts to make words and identifying and reviewing sight words. Our newest sight word is **can**.

In math, we counted and identified numbers to 20. We completed patterns using movement and we built block towers, counted the blocks and knocked them down. Today, on Valentine's Day, we sorted Hersey kisses by color and graphed the amount of each color, and copied patterns with conversation hearts. You will find bags of kisses and hearts in folders and back packs. We also enjoyed making Valentines and decorating our Valentine card holders. It's been a fun day!
